AN ACT Relating to Appointment of State Humane Agents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 1214, amended. Section 1214 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the first sentence 4 new sentences to read as follows:

'At least one state humane agent shall be appointed from each county. The Division of Animal Industry of the Department of Agriculture shall coordinate and assist the various counties in carrying out this chapter and may require reports on cases investigated or prosecuted. The Division of Animal Industry shall investigate and appraise the qualifications of applicants and submit its findings to the Governor and Council. Any full-time employee of any humane society shall be appointed a state humane agent upon request of such society.'
