## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salary and Providing Travel Allowance of Indian Representative at the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 3, § 2, amended. The last paragraph of section 2 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The member of the Indian tribe elected by it to represent the tribe at the biennial assembly of the Legislature shall receive a compensation of \$250 \$500 for such attendance. Such member of the Indian tribe shall be paid for travel at each legislative session once each week when he attends at the same rate per mile to and from his place of abode as state employees receive, the mileage to be determined by the most reasonable direct route.'
