IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Lincoln Home, Newcastle, for Well Damage by Highway Construction.

Lincoln Home; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,000 to be paid to the Lincoln Home in Newcastle, as a full and final settlement of their claim against the State for damages, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to their well, caused during the construction of highway U.S. Route I in Newcastle.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Lincoln Home in Newcastle had well damage done during 1963 when the State Highway Commission was building a new road, U. S. Route 1 in Newcastle. The sum of \$1,000 to be paid to the Lincoln Home as a final settlement to their claim.
