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**RESOLVE, in Favor of New Canada Plantation for Sly Brook Road  
Construction.**

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**New Canada Plantation; appropriation. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to New Canada Plantation the sum of \$7,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 to match federal funds under the Accelerated Public Works Program for construction from easterly boundary of Wallagrass Plantation for 1½ miles in a northerly direction along Sly Brook Road, so-called.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Sly Brook Road is a lake road on which there are no camps. The total cost of the construction is \$21,000, of which amount \$14,000 of federal funds are available.
