COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 129, L.D. 153, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Expenditure of Town Road Improvement Funds."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause,
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do
not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the
Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the betterment of the unimproved roads in the
State is of utmost importance for the economic well-being of
the people of the State of Maine; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary
so that expenditure of town road improvement moneys may be made in
the spring of 1965; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof, the
following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
