STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Expenditure of Town Road Improvement Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1705, amended. Section 1705 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1705. Expenditures. The expenditures of this fund shall not exceed the sum of \$6,000 \$9,000 in any one mile. The various towns shall assume and pay any cost or damages arising from any change in location, grade or drainage.'
