AN ACT Relating to Use of Fuel Fires in Tents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 12, § 1401, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 1401 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is repealed, as follows :

~~'Out of door fires include the use of sterno, gasoline, charcoal or other fuel fires in or out of tents and collapsible shelters, but such fuels may be used at state highway picnic areas.'~~
