HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 131, L.D. 155, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Bow and Arrow Hunting on Mount Desert Island, Hancock  
County."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof, the following:

'Referendum; effective date; certificates to Secretary of State.

This Act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters within each of the Towns of Bar Harbor, Mount Desert, Southwest Harbor and Tremont, present and voting at the annual town meeting held in 1966 by said towns, respectively. The town clerks in the respective towns shall reduce the subject matter of this Act to the following question: "Shall the Act Relating to Bow and Arrow Hunting on Mount Desert Island, Hancock County, passed by the 102nd Legislature, be accepted?" The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This Act shall take effect for all purposes hereof after its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters voting on the question at town meetings in each of the 4 above-named towns.

The results of all votes to accept or reject this Act in said towns shall be declared by the municipal officers of the Towns of Bar Harbor, Mount Desert, Southwest Harbor and Tremont, respectively, and returns filed by the town clerks with the Secretary of State.'
