COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 132, L.D. 156, Bill, "An  
Act Relating to Hunting Rabbits on Mount Desert  
Island, Hancock County."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the Title the word  
"Rabbits"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the  
4th, 5th, 6th and 7th lines and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

"It shall be unlawful to hunt on Mount Desert  
Island, Hancock County, with other than .22 cal. rifles,  
.22 cal. pistols or shotguns loaded with nothing larger  
than #6 shot only."
