IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting Rabbits on Mount Desert Island, Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2356, amended. Section 2356 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the 3rd paragraph a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘During the open season it shall be unlawful to hunt rabbits on Mount Desert Island, Hancock County, with other than .22 cal. rifles or shotguns loaded with bird shot only.’
