STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters in Penobscot and Piscataquis Counties.

Fishing regulated; Penobscot and Piscataquis Counties. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation relating to the following waters in Penobscot County and Piscataquis County:

Penobscot County

Sandy Stream, T2, R8 and T3, R8, to establish a 5 fish daily bag limit.

Mud Brook, T2, R8 and T3, R8, to establish a 5 fish daily bag limit.

Katahdin Lake, T3, R8, to establish a general law bag limit and to prohibit the use or possession of live fish as bait.

Rocky Pond, T₃, R₈, to establish a general law bag limit, to prohibit the use or possession of live fish as bait and close to all ice fishing.

Trout Pond, T2, R7, to establish a 5 fish daily bag limit, to prohibit the use or possession of live fish as bait and close to all ice fishing.

Moose Pond, T3, R8, to establish a 5 fish daily bag limit, to prohibit the use or possession of live fish as bait and close to all ice fishing.

Millinocket Lake, T1, R9 and T2, R9, in addition to the existing ice fishing regulations, to permit night fishing for smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until March 31st.

Piscataquis County

Slaughter Pond, T3, R11, to establish a general law bag limit and to prohibit the use or possession of live fish as bait.

Upper Togue Pond, T2, R9, to permit ice fishing for pickerel, hornpout, white perch, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time ice forms in the fall until March 31st. Open to all fish, except bass, during February and March.

Lower Togue Pond, T2, R9, to permit ice fishing for pickerel, hornpout, white perch, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time ice forms in the fall until March 31st. Open to all fish, except bass, during February and March.

Millinocket Lake, T1, R8 and T2, R8, in addition to the existing ice fishing regulations, to permit night fishing for smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until March 31st.
