**AN ACT Relating to Persons Having Right to Redeem Mortgaged Premises.**

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 14, § 6301, amended.** Section 6301 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

**'A person other than a mortgagor or his heirs, successors or assigns shall not be deemed to have a right to redeem under this section unless he shall have first brought the action, upon which his claim is based, to final judgment.'**
