

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 102ND LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 138, L.D. 161, Bill, "An Act Relating to Decisions Under Liquor Law Pending Appeal."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 3 underlined lines of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

"if notice of appeal is given to the commission within 7 days of the sending of the decision of the Administrative Hearing <u>Commissioner by registered or certified mail to the address</u> given by the licensee at the time of his application for a <u>license</u>."

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 2 underlined lines of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

"<u>commission within 7 days of the sending of the decision of</u> <u>the Administrative Hearing Commissioner by registered</u> or <u>certified mail to the address given by the licensee at the</u> <u>time of his application for a license.</u>"
