STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Decisions Under Liquor Law Pending Appeal.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 28, § 402, amended. The last sentence of section 402 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Pending judgment of the commission, the decision of the Administrative Hearing Commissioner in revoking or suspending any license shall remain in full force and effect be suspended, if notice of appeal is given to the commission within 3 days of receipt of the decision of the Administrative Hearing Commissioner.'

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 28, § 403, amended. The 6th sentence of section 403 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Pending judgment of the court, the decision of the commission in revoking or suspending any license shall remain in full force and effect be suspended, if notice of appeal is given to the commission within 3 days of receipt of the decision of the commission.'
