STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Unifying Sanford and Springvale Fire Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Unifying Sanford and Springvale fire departments null and void. The approval by ordinance, to be effective January 1, 1965, of the representative town meeting of the Town of Sanford to unify the fire departments of Sanford and Springvale into one department and one chief shall be null and void, since this action was decisively reversed by the registered voters of the Town of Sanford at an election held on December 28, 1964, even though less than 20% of all the registered voters of the Town of Sanford so voted.
