STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Compensation of Courcilmen of City of South Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1963, c. 162, Art. II, § 209, amended. Section 209 of article II of chapter 162 of the private and special laws of 1963 is amended to read as follows:

'209. Compensation. The annual compensation of councilmen shall be \$600 \$1,000. The compensation of councilmen shall be established and fixed by provisions of the charter.'
