COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 149, L. D. 172, Bill, "An Act
Providing for Adult Identification Cards Under Liquor
Law.'

Amend said Bill in the 5th line by inserting after the
underlined word "State" the underlined words 'or nonresident
in the State'

Further amend said Bill in the 20th line by inserting after
the underlined words "enforcement officer" the underlined words
'in carrying out his duties relating to liquor'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the single quotation
mark at the end and inserting in place thereof the following
underlined sentence: "The failure of any person in possession of
intoxicating liquors to produce an adult identification card
shall be prima facie evidence of the fact that such person is
under the age of 21 years." "
