HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 149, L.D. 172, Bill, "An Act Providing
for Adult Identification Cards Under Liquor Law."

Amend said Bill in the 5th line by inserting after the
underlined word "State" the underlined words 'or nonresident
in the State'

Further amend said Bill in the 20th line by inserting
after the underlined words "enforcement officer" the underlined
words 'in carrying out his duties relating to liquor'

Further amend said Bill in the 3rd paragraph from the
end by striking out, in the last 2 lines, the underlined words
"and shall be punished by a fine of \$50, which fine shall not
be suspended"
