**AN ACT Relating to Hours for Sale of Liquor by Hotels and Class A
Restaurants.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 4, amended. Section 4 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the first sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'Liquor may be sold by licensed hotels with cocktail lounges, so-called, and by licensed class A restaurants until 1 a.m.'
