SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 152, L. D. 175, Bill,
"An Act Relating to Stock of Merchandise in Retail Stores
Under Liquor Law."

inserting in place thereof the following:

'All retail store licensees must have and maintain
an adequate stock of groceries in no case less than
\$1,000 wholesale value.'
