STATE OF MAINE SENATE 102nd LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 154, L. D. 177, Bill, "An Act to Create the Brewer Sewerage District."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first sentence of the referendum and inserting in place thereof the following:

'This Act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of the Legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters within said district, voting by ballot, at the regular municipal election or at an election to be specially called and held for the purpose within one year after the effective date of this Act.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the next to the last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

'This Act shall take effect immediately upon its acceptance by at least a majority vote of the legal voters voting at such election, provided that the total vote for and against the acceptance of this Act at said election equals or exceeds 10% of the total vote for all candidates for Governor cast at the next previous gubernatorial election in said district.'
