**AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Weight Violations of Trucks.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 29, § 1654, amended.** The first 5 paragraphs of section 1654 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes are repealed and the following paragraph enacted in place thereof:

**'Any person who violates any provision of section 1652 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor on account of each such violation and, for each violation of which convicted, shall be punished for the first offense by a fine of not more than \$100 and upon any subsequent conviction by a fine of not more than \$150.'**
