**AN ACT Providing Stamped Envelopes When Sales Tax Forms Sent by State
Tax Assessor.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 1951, amended. Section 1951 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the first sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'When any such form is sent to a retailer, the State Tax Assessor shall include a stamped envelope addressed to the State Tax Assessor, which envelope shall be used by the retailer to file his completed form with the State Tax Assessor.'
