IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of County Attorney and Assistant County Attorney of York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 17th paragraph, which relates to York County, of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'York County: County commissioners, \$1,750; clerk of courts, \$5,500; deputy clerk of courts, \$4,200; county attorney, \$5,000 \$7,500; assistant county attorney, \$3,500 \$5,000; county treasurer, \$1,750; sherif, \$4,750; register of deeds, \$5,200; judge of probate, \$6,500; register of probate, \$4,500.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General; the sum of \$2,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$4,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to provide for the increase in salary of the county attorney and the assistant county attorney of York County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
