STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Clerk of Courts, County Attorney and Sheriff of Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 13th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sagadahoc County: County commissioners, \$1,000; clerk of courts, \$4,200 \$5,000; county attorney, \$4,000 \$5,200; county treasurer, \$1,700; sheriff, \$4,100 \$5,750; register of deeds, \$4,200; judge of probate, \$3,000; register of probate, \$3,000.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$1,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to provide for the increase in salary of the county attorney of Sagadahoc County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
