STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD MINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Permitting County Commissioners of Somerset County to Combine Certain Unorganized Territory Road Accounts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain unorganized territory road accounts combined. The county commissioners of Somerset County are authorized to combine the moneys in the following road accounts and to expend said moneys for maintenance and snow removal on the New Road to Long Falls, Somerset County, such road being entirely within the unorganized territory.

The road accounts are as follows:

T. 3, R. 3, (Dead River)—1.17 miles; T. 2, R. 3, B. K. P., W. K. R. (Carrying Place Town)—6.80 miles; T. 3, R. 4, B. K. P., W. K. R. (Spring Lake)—1.86 miles.
