AN ACT Prohibiting Stickers on Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1371, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1371, to read as follows:

'Sec. 1371. Stickers. No person shall drive any motor vehicle with any sign, poster, sticker or other material upon such motor vehicle. This section shall not apply to an official inspection sticker or any advertising which is an integral part of the body finish.'
