COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 181, L.D. 202, Bill, "An Act Relating to Display of Lights on Motor Vehicles During Fog."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding the following new section:

"Sec. 2. R. S. , T. 29, §1366, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 1366 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Said lamps and lights shall conform to and operate in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated from time to time by the Secretary of State, and shall be lighted during the period from $\frac{1}{2}$ hour after sunset to $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before sunrise, and at any time when, due to insufficient light or unfavorable atmospheric condition, caused by fog or otherwise, persons and vehicles on the highway are not clearly discernible for a distance of 500 feet ahead, except as provided in section 1755.' "
