HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 25, L.D. 203, Bill, "An Act Repealing Milk Control Prices at the Retail Level."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following new section:

"Sec. 2. R. S., T. 7, §2958-A, additional. Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2958-A to read as follows:

' §2958-A. Limitation

No milk shall be sold in the State of Maine unless such milk has been produced no more than 3 days prior to such sale. This section shall not apply to over-the-counter sales of milk by stores to consumers.' "
