SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 25, L. D.203, Bill, "An Act Repealing
Milk Control Prices at the Retail Level."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by striking out everything
after the words "An Act" and inserting in place thereof the words
'Defining Person Under Milk Control Law.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 7, §2951, sub-§7, amended. Subsection 7 of section
2951 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'7. Person. "Person" means any individual, partnership, firm,
corporation, association or other unit, and except charitable
hospitals and the State and all political subdivisions or agencies
thereof, ~~except-state-owned-and-operated-institutions~~ including, but
not limited to, School Administrative Districts and community school
districts.'"
