## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Permitting Livermore Falls Water District to Take Water from Tilton Pond, Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1907, c. 390, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 390 of the private and special laws of 1907 is amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. Taking of waters from certain ponds. The said district, for the purpose of its incorporation, is hereby authorized to take, hold, divert, use and distribute water from Moose Hill Pond, so-called, in said East Livermore and from the North Livermore Ponds, so-called, situated in the Town of Livermore and from Tilton Pond, so-called, situated in the Town of Fayette, Kennebec County.'
