**AN ACT Relating to Itemized Statements Filed by and Identification Badges
for Legislative Counsel and Agents.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 3, § 314-A, additional. Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 314-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 314-A. Identification badges. Each legislative counsel and agent shall at all times while in the state house wear an identification badge. Such badges shall be furnished by the Secretary of State and sold to each counsel and agent at cost. Such badges shall contain such information as may be determined by the Secretary of State.’

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 3, § 314-B, additional. Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 314-B, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 314-B. Statements. Within 30 days after final adjournment of the Legislature, every legislative counsel or agent shall file with the Secretary of State an itemized statement of his fees and expenditures in connection with such legislative employment and by whom paid or to whom charged. Such statement shall be in such form as the Secretary of State may prescribe and shall be open to public inspection.’
