STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Inspection of Certain Farm Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, Sec. 2122, amended. Section 2122 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'This section shall not apply to farm trucks used solely to transport manure, hay or corn silage to or from a farm lot and between farm lots, provided the brakes and running gear conform to the requirements of this section. A certificate of inspection of a color to be determined by the Chief of State Police shall be used to carry out this paragraph.'
