**AN ACT Exempting Firemen from Waiting Period Under Workmen's
Compensation.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 53, amended. Section 53 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 53. Waiting period; when compensation payable. No compensation for incapacity to work shall be payable for the first 7 days of incapacity, **except that firemen shall receive compensation from the date of incapacity.** In case incapacity continues for more than 21 days, compensation shall be allowed from the date of incapacity.'
