STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Officials of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 6th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Hancock County: County commissioners, \$1,450; clerk of courts, \$3,750 \$4,500; deputy clerk of courts, \$2,600 \$3,350; county attorney, \$4,500; county treasurer, \$2,350 \$2,600; sheriff, \$4,250 \$4,750; register of deeds, \$3,750 \$4,500; judge of probate, \$4,250; register of probate, \$3,750 \$4,500.'
