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**AN ACT Relating to Licensing Dogs in Unorganized Territory.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 7, § 3453, amended.** Section 3453 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

**'Dogs kept in unorganized territories where there is no duly authorized dog recorder shall be licensed by the owner or keeper in the nearest municipality or unorganized territory having a dog recorder.'**
