COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 79, L. D. 224, Bill, "An Act
Appropriating Funds for the Establishment of a Speech and
Hearing Referral and Training Center at the Farmington
State Teachers College."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first paragraph
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund
the sum of \$22,870 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the
sum of \$11,130 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967, to the
Farmington State Teachers College for the establishment of a Speech
and Hearing Referral and Training Center. The breakdown shall be as
follows:
