## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 102nd LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 87, L. D. 231, Bill, "An Act Approving the Course of Study in Private Schools."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 20, §102, sub-§7, amended. Subsection 7 of section 102 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, 2 new paragraphs, to read as follows:

'The officers in charge of a private school or camp school, including summer schools which admit students who have not satisfactorily completed grade 12 in an approved secondary school, shall furnish the commissioner (of Education) with a copy of the course of study arranged by said officers, and when approved by him after observation and study, it shall become the authorized course of study for said private school.

Schools already in good standing in the Independent

Secondary School Division of the New England Association of Colleges

and Secondary Schools, and summer schools conducted by these schools,

shall be exempted from this section.' "
