AN ACT Approving the Course of Study in Private Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 102, sub-§ 7, amended. Subsection 7 of section 102 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'The trustees or other officers in charge of a private school, including summer schools and postsecondary schools except degree-granting institutions, shall furnish the commissioner (of Education) with a copy of the course of study arranged by said officers, and when approved by him it shall become the authorized course of study for said private school.'
