STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Search of Lost Persons in the Woodlands of the State.

Reimburse Department of Inland Fisheries and Game for money spent to find lost persons. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game the sum of \$3,612.40 to reimburse the department for expenses incurred during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964 for attempting to find lost persons in the woodlands of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Under the Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 1903, the expenses of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game in attempting to find lost persons in the woodlands of the State is chargeable to the General Fund. The purpose of this resolve is to reimburse the department for expenses incurred during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964.
