COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 184, L.D. 239, Bill,
"An Act Relating to Appropriation to Adjust State Employees'
Pay."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
General Fund the sum of \$750,000 for the fiscal year ending
June 30, 1966, and the sum of \$1,500,000 for the fiscal year
ending June 30, 1967, to be effectuated as of the first pay
period in January, 1966. The above appropriated funds are for
both classified and unclassified positions in the General
Fund. Any balance at June 30, 1966 shall not lapse but shall
carry forward into the 1966-67 fiscal year to be used for the
same purpose.

The breakdown shall be as follows:
