**RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Fifty Copies of History of Brownfield,
Bicentennial Edition.**

History of Brownfield; purchase of. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$250 for the State to purchase 50 copies of the book entitled History of Brownfield at \$5 per copy; said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Town of Brownfield is celebrating its 200th anniversary this year. The printing of the "History of Brownfield" is very appropriate at this time. It has been the practice of the Legislature to encourage such historic books, which helps to preserve the history of our State by purchasing copies for distribution by the State Librarian.
