RESOLVE, to Purchase Fifty Copies of "History of Madison."

Appropriation; purchase of "History of Madison." Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$500 for the State to purchase 50 copies of the book entitled the "History of Madison," compiled by Emma Folsom Clark in collaboration with William and Violet Cassidy, Marguerite Barley Hurd and Blanche Hilma Look, at \$10 per copy, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This book covers the early history of the Town of Madison and contains valuable source material not previously printed. It has long been the practice of the Legislature to encourage the publication of works which help to preserve the history of the State, by purchasing copies for distribution to libraries. It seems particularly fitting that the Legislature show its interest in the history of the Town of Madison.
