**AN ACT Providing for Group Insurance for Civilian Technicians Employed by
the Military.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 712, amended. Section 712 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘Without cost or liability to the State at any time, the Adjutant General may enter into insuring agreements with authorized insurance carriers for group life insurance or group health and accident insurance or prepayment plans for hospital and medical service or insurance for the army and air technicians employed by the military establishment as state employees and paid from federal funds.’
