AN ACT Relating to Uninsured Motorist Coverage in Insurance Policies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 24, § 502, sub-§ 22, additional. Section 502 of Title 24 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 22, to read as follows :

‘22. Uninsured motorist. Any policy insuring against liability resulting from or incident to the ownership, maintenance or use of a vehicle shall contain a provision for protection against uninsured motorists for bodily injury, but any policyholder shall have the right to reject such provision.’
