AN ACT Permitting Municipalities to Raise Money for Blood Service Programs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 5105, sub-§ 3-A, additional. Section 5105 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 3-A to read as follows:

'3-A. Blood service. Supporting a blood service program.'
