**AN ACT Providing for Research of Commercial Fishery Resources by
Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 12, § 3705, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 3705 to read as follows :

‘Sec. 3705. Commercial fishery resources. The department, under the direction of the commissioner, is authorized to conduct a program or programs for research and development of the commercial fishery resources of the State, including but not limited to the construction of permanent and temporary facilities and including but not limited to market research, in conformity with the requirements of Federal Public Law 88-309 and amendments thereto. The department, under the direction of the commissioner, is authorized to consolidate existing research or development projects and those projects hereafter created as part of said program. The department, under the direction of the commissioner, is authorized to seek and expend matching federal funds for the purposes of this section, and to accept donations from industry and interested corporations and persons for the purposes of this section.’
