STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Judge of Probate and Register of Probate of Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 11th paragraph, which relates to Penobscot County, of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Penobscot County: County commissioners, \$2,500; clerk of courts, \$5,500; deputy clerk of courts, \$4,500; county attorney, \$5,500; assistant county attorney, \$4,250; county treasurer, \$3,500; sheriff, \$5,300; register of deeds, \$5,000; judge of probate, \$5,500 \$7,500; register of probate, \$4,800.'
