IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of County Attorney and Assistant County Attorney of Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. That part of the 11th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to the salary of county attorney and assistant county attorney, is amended to read as follows:

'county attorney, \$5,500 \$**7,500**; assistant county attorney, \$4,250 **\$5,000**;'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$1,375 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$2,750 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to provide for the increase in the salaries of the county attorney and the assistant county attorney of Penobscot County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
