SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 211,
L. D. 279, Bill, "An Act Relating to Permits by Highway
Commission for Trucks in Construction Areas."

Amend said Amendment by striking out the quotation marks at
the end and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Construction equipment on pneumatic tires and low-bed tractor
trailer trucks shall be granted a permit for a distance of 50 miles
from the point of loading for a weight limit of 66,000 pounds for a
3-axle unit, 88,000 pounds for a 4-axle unit and 110,000 pounds for
a 5-axle unit. This permit shall be granted for a fee of \$100 for
one year. The width limit for this permit shall be 12 feet and
the overall length for crane and shovel booms shall be at least
75 feet. The permit holder shall be liable for all damages to
bridges which he uses that are posted for a weight that the permit
exceeds. This paragraph shall not permit, validate or in any way
apply to the use of the Interstate System as defined in the Federal
Aid Highway Act of 1956 by vehicles with weights and lengths in
excess of the applicable maximum weights and lengths permitted by
said Federal Aid Highway Act of 1956."
